

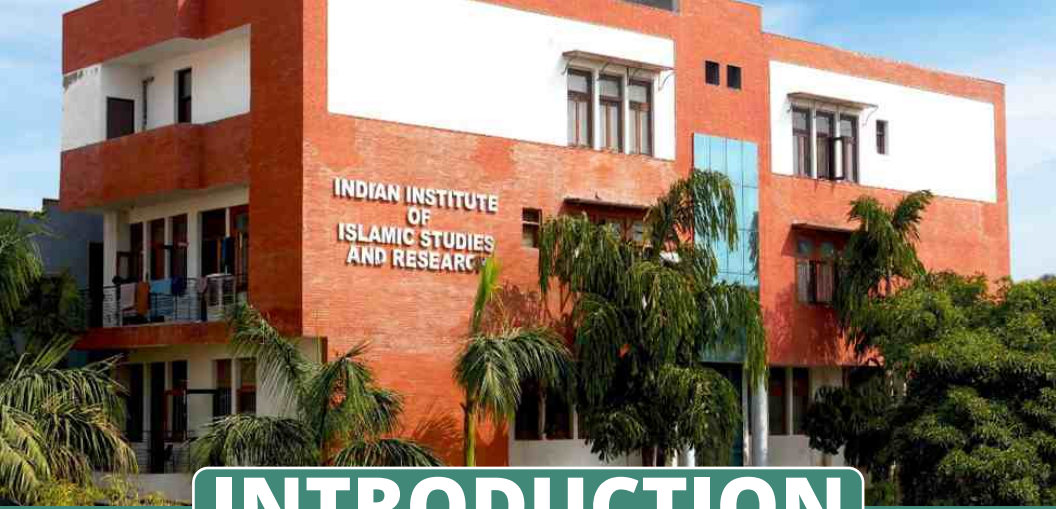

INTRODUCTION

Islami Academy Trust was established in 2005. Since its inception, the trust has facilitated higher studies in Islamic studies for hundreds of talented students from both College and Madrasa backgrounds across India. The academy aims to improve the standards and prospects of higher education within the Muslim community, and to facilitate research in Islamic studies in the context of Indian society, religions, cultures, traditions, and history.

To focus its efforts on higher education, the Trust launched the Indian Institute of Islamic Studies and Research (IIISR) in 2016. At the institute, we offer the following residential study programs:

1) First Year:

- a. **One Year Diploma in Arabic Language and Islamic Studies**
- b. **One Year Diploma in English Language and Social Sciences**

2) Second Year:

- a. **One Year Advanced Diploma in Arabic language and Islamic Thought**
- b. **One Year Advanced Diploma in Comparative Religion and Social Sciences**

3) Third Year:

- a. **One Year Research Assistant** (Islamic Thought, Comparative Religion, Social Sciences Languages and Education)

4) Fourth Year:

- a. **One Year Research Associate** (Islamic Thought, Comparative Religion, Social Sciences Languages and Education)

Admission to our residential study programs is based on a nationwide entrance test with examination centres across the country. Shortlisted candidates are called for an interview at the IISR campus in New Delhi, and admission is finalised on the basis of merit. Deserving students are offered full fellowships that cover their expenses on food and lodging. Additionally, students are provided a stipend as per the terms and conditions of the Institute. Our residential study programs place a strong emphasis on the overall personality development of students.

In addition to the above mentioned residential programs, IISR also offers several non-residential academic programs. Since March 2017, it has been running two batches (separately for boys and girls) of one Year Certificate Course in Quranic Language and Teachings for homemakers and working professionals in Delhi. In 2020, the Department of Distance and Online Learning was founded at IISR.

Thousands of students have benefited from various certificate and crash courses conducted since then.





A MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

The Indian Institute of Islamic Studies and Research (IISR) is a specialised institute for higher education and research. Our goal is to prepare a new generation of young people for the development of human knowledge and consciousness, especially in the field of social sciences, in the light of the divine guidance of the Quran and Sunnah. Additionally, our aim is to help our students understand the different civilisational contexts of religion and society in India. Developing an Islamic environment for Tazkiya (purification of the self) and the overall development of students is our foremost priority.

In Indian Muslim society, there are two types of educational institutes: religious seminaries (Madaris) and modern colleges and universities. However, there is a gap between these two streams of education. One objective of IISR is to bring together graduates from both streams and, through lectures, seminars, assignments, and mutual dialogue, remove the respective deficiencies of their streams, breed enthusiasm, and cultivate knowledge and capabilities. Madaris are usually run on the basis of Maslak (sectarian orientation), but at IISR, students from different Madaris and Masalik (sects) learn together and engage in a meaningful dialogue.
